

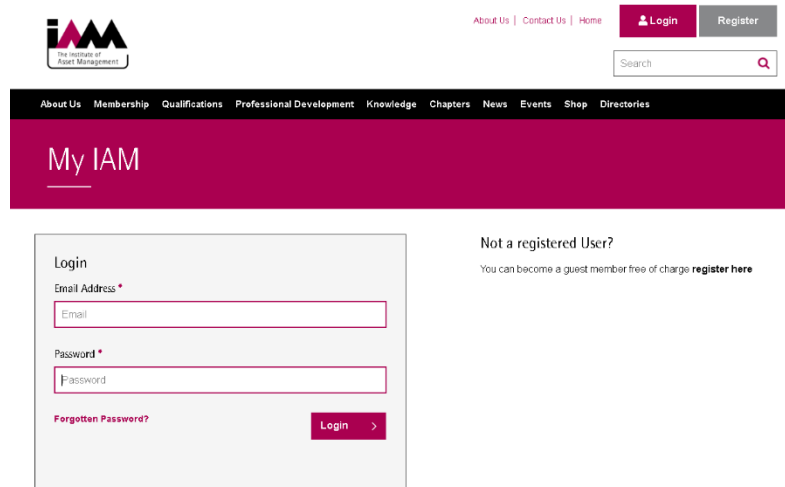

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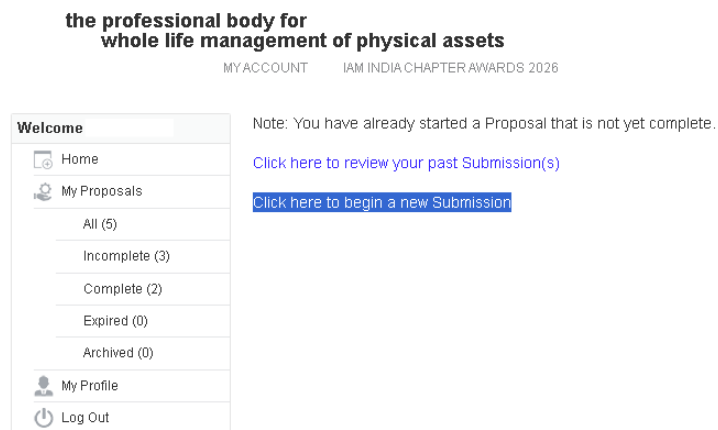

Your title should state exactly what the session is: approach plus outcome, e.g., "Risk-Based Renewal Planning for Ageing Water Networks." Avoid project codenames, unexplained acronyms, puns and clever-but-vague phrasing. Reviewers and, later, delegates should know what you are offering from the title alone.

Formulate learning objectives before drafting the abstract. State two to four objectives describing what attendees will be able to do following the session, each beginning with an active verb like define, apply, plan, evaluate, demonstrate, or propose. Terms such as "understand" or "appreciate" are not assessable and should be avoided. Each objective should be achievable within a 30–40 minute session; reviewers assess whether the session is designed around delegate capability.

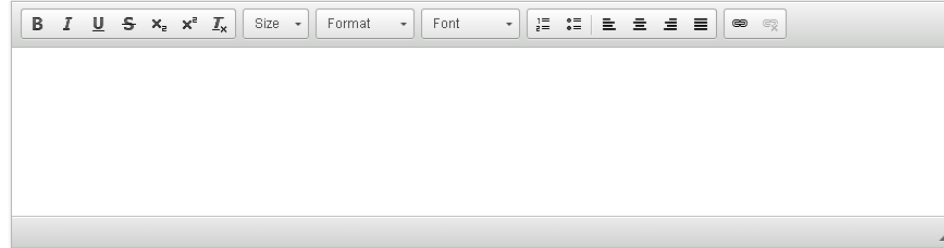
c. Audience:

Maximum word count: 200

Audience *

Is the projected audience newcomers or experienced hands or somewhere in between? If the information is role specific, such as maintenance or finance, how will you make it applicable to all roles? If the information is sector specific, such as water or transportation, how will you make it suitable for all sectors?

Identify the primary audience with precision — for example, "mid-level practitioners in infrastructure-intensive sectors." Claims of universal relevance without supporting explanation are scored unfavourably. Where content is role- or sector-specific, state the mechanism of transfer explicitly, such as demonstrating a sector-agnostic framework through worked examples from two sectors. Reviewers use this section to assess audience awareness and to position the session within the programme.

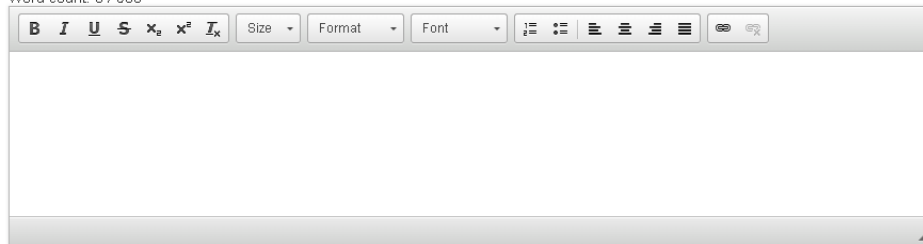
d. Abstract:

Maximum word count: 500

Abstract *

Please focus on the content of the presentation and the characteristics of the organization behind it. If it is a case study or how to, a sequence of events is helpful. Descriptions of the key players are also helpful.

Write the abstract with the stated objectives and audience in mind. For industry submissions, reviewers assess, in sequence: (1) context: organisation type, asset base, and scale; (2) the problem and its trigger; (3) the sequence of events: actions taken, by whom (by role), and in what order; (4) outcomes, quantified wherever possible; and (5) an honest statement of limitations, which strengthens credibility. For academic and research submissions, present the research question, methodology, data or validation basis, findings, and limitations, with emphasis on relevance to asset management practice rather than theoretical novelty alone. Commercial promotion and aspiration presented as achievement are grounds for rejection. Organisational and institutional names may be included; entries are anonymised prior to double-blind review.

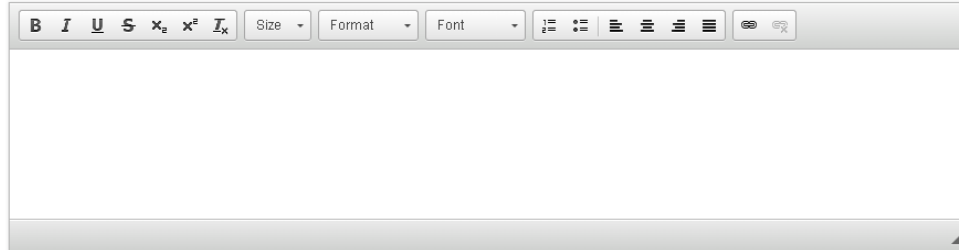
e. Practical Applications:

Why is this information important in the real world? How will the objectives be useful in developing or improving asset management?

Establish the value of the work beyond the authoring organisation or institution. For industry work, state what delegates will take away — a framework, checklist, or method — and the conditions under which it transfers. For research, articulate the pathway from findings to practice: what practitioners can apply now, what requires further validation, and where industry collaboration would accelerate adoption. A concise reference to recognised practice, such as ISO 55001, assists reviewers in positioning the contribution. Evidence of reuse or citation beyond the authors' own team is the strongest support. Project benefits and research findings belong in the abstract, not here.

Please give a short, 50 word description of your presentation. This will be used for the conference app and online promotion if you are invited to speak.

This should be written last, as a distillation of the submission. If selected, these fifty words appear verbatim in the conference application and promotional material; final, publishable text is therefore required: one sentence on the topic, one on the approach, and one on the delegate takeaway, consistent in scope with the abstract. Generic phrasing such as "this session explores challenges and opportunities" should be avoided.
